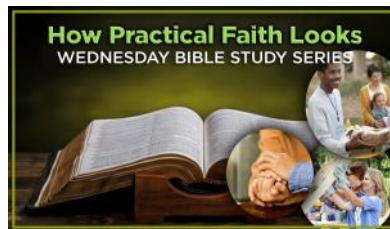


Wednesday Bible Study

Numbers 11:1-6
